2026 STREET PROJECTS

Street improvements are on the way!

In addition to the state of Minnesota working on Hwy 11, from Roseau to Warroad, and the completion of the east side of the bridge in Warroad, we will be repairing Lake St NW from Hwy 11 west (by the Hampton & Circle K) west to Cedar Ave NW. Project will consist of mill and overlay only. There will not be any water or sewer replacement needs.

It's Time for Spring Yard Clean Up!

City of Warroad residents...it's time to clean up the debris in your yards, basements, and anywhere else you have unwanted debris lying around! The first 3 Thursdays of May have been designated as yard clean-up weeks! Please do your part to help get the community cleaned up for summer!



Grass, Leaves, Brush: Thursdays – May 7th, 14th and 21st have been designated for these special pick-ups. Branches should be cut in 3 ft. pieces and bundled. Leaves and grass clippings should be put in untied plastic bags in your normal refuse collection spot. Trashmasters will be around to pick it up.

Additional Items: If you missed the City wide clean up in April, Trashmasters will pick up additional large items for a minimal fee during these three designated yard clean-up weeks. Furniture, mattress, appliances, tires, computer monitors, and televisions can be removed for \$20 each on your normal service day. Payment needs to be made at time of pickup as it cannot be added to your utility bill. There are certain items they cannot take: fluorescent bulbs, car batteries, motor oil, hazardous materials, and cement blocks. If excessively large amounts are going to be left, please make prior arrangements with Trashmasters.

Construction Debris WILL NOT be accepted.

Inoperable/Unlicensed Vehicle Removal

Residents are reminded that the City of Warroad maintains a nuisance ordinance governing private property maintenance. *One of the most common violations is the storage of inoperable and/or unlicensed or unregistered vehicles, boats, 4-wheelers, motorcycles, and vehicle parts, etc. outside of an enclosed structure.* Any of these that are not licensed, or cannot be operated in their current state due to flat tires, missing parts or other conditions, must be stored within a fully enclosed garage or storage building or removed from the property immediately. Junk vehicles can be taken to an auto recycler who may pay you cash for your vehicle.

Residents can notify the Warroad Police Department of any abandoned vehicles or vehicles in your neighborhood that are being stored in violation of the City's ordinance at 218-386-2053.

Let's Beautify Warroad!

The Planning Commission will once again be focusing on the City's Nuisance Ordinance. The City requests that property owners do their part in keeping Warroad and especially their own neighborhood, a clean, safe and enjoyable place to live by doing their part to clean up and tidy up their property. Let's get Warroad cleaned up and looking great!

General Property Maintenance.... Examples of conditions/items not acceptable in plain view or in the open.

- Construction Waste
- Vegetation (leaves, grass, branches, dirt, etc.)
- Furniture/Appliances
- Bags of Garbage/loose garbage
- Junk Bicycles
- Residents should maintain their lawn, shrubs, trees, etc. in well groomed condition.

Whoever by his or her act or failure to perform a legal duty intentionally violates Ordinance No. 94 is guilty of maintaining a public nuisance, which is a misdemeanor.
